Chiefs Report:

- 1. Calls to Date in 2023 were 116 and 2024 is 91.
- 2. Impact fee in 2023 was 13 and 2024 is 5.
- 3. One of the new brush trucks is in service and will be available for the wildland season.

- 4. DFPC wildland forecast is an average Colorado season with 250,000-300,000 acres will burn, Last year was an average season.
- 5. Our 2024 Wildland Field Day is tomorrow.
- 6. DFPCDPC water rescue equipment is here.
- 7. SAFER Grant was submitted for 3 positions for 3 years.
- 8. We did acquire a structure for Training last 2 Wednesdays and will be burning down the entire Structure on May 4 th
- 9. State backfills from the State Bill 22-238 and Senate Bill 23B-001 total \$72,021.
- 10. SB24-194 will help fire districts with diversifying funding
- 11. In collaboration with HFPD Auxiliary, we are starting a community outreach pancake breakfast. The first one will be
 - 1) May 11th and will be Home Safety
 - 2) June 8th Wildland Preparedness
 - 3) July 13th Home Mitigation
 - 4) August 10th Community Risk Reduction
 - 5) September 14 th Winter Preparedness
